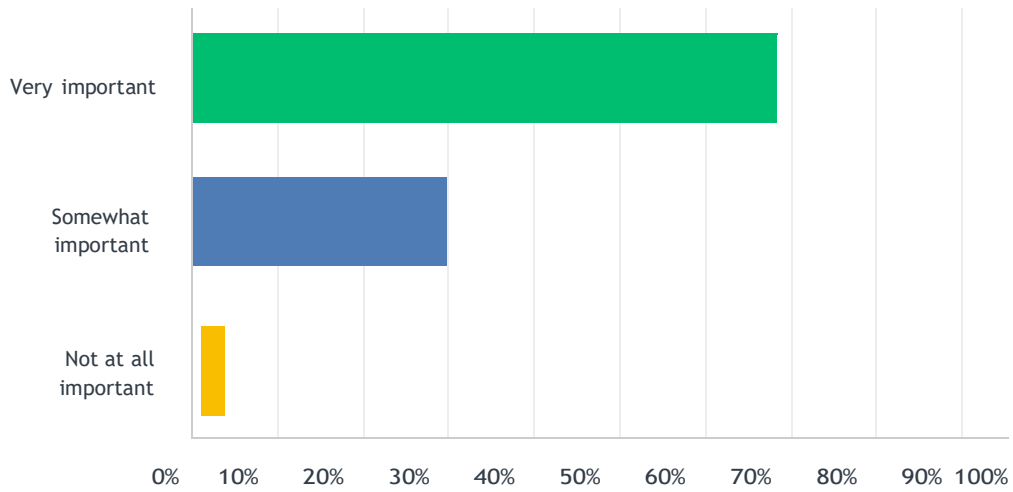


## How important are pedestrian safety improvements to your quality of life?

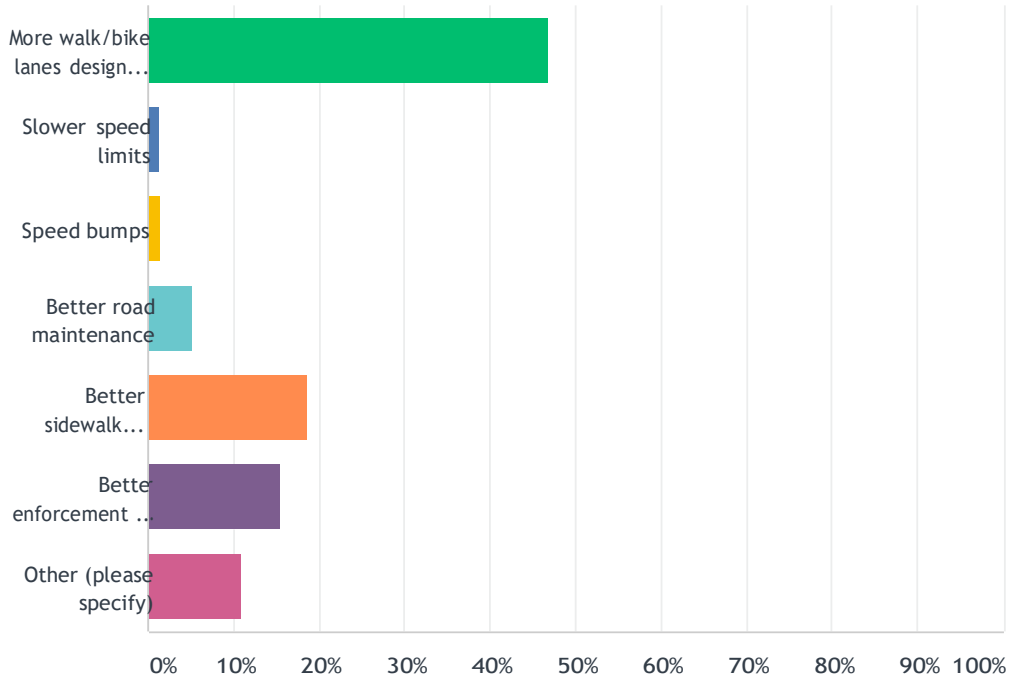

## What is the most important improvement to increase your ability to walk in New London? Pick only one

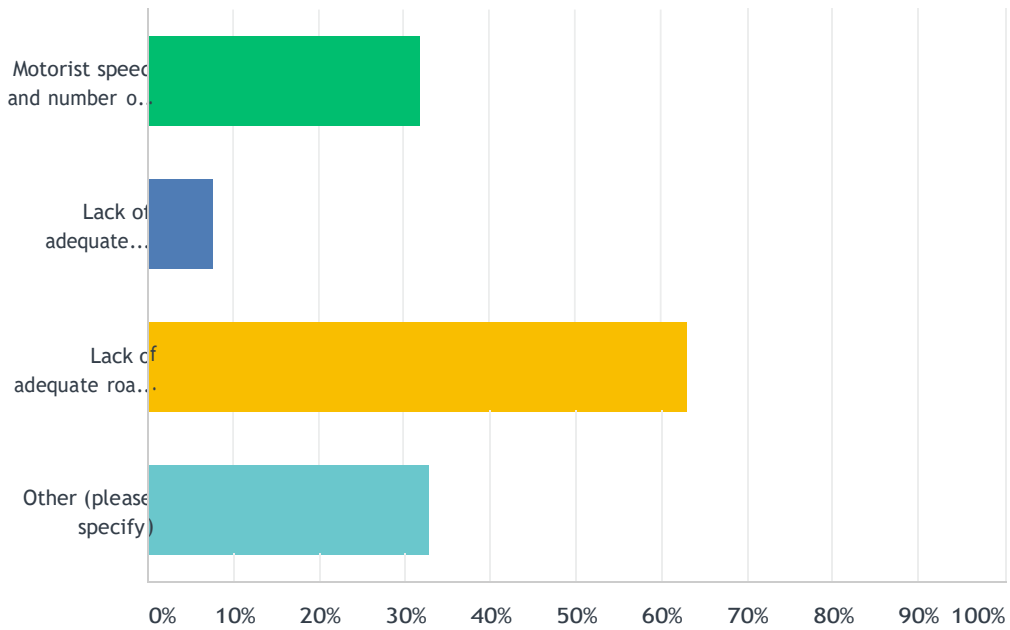

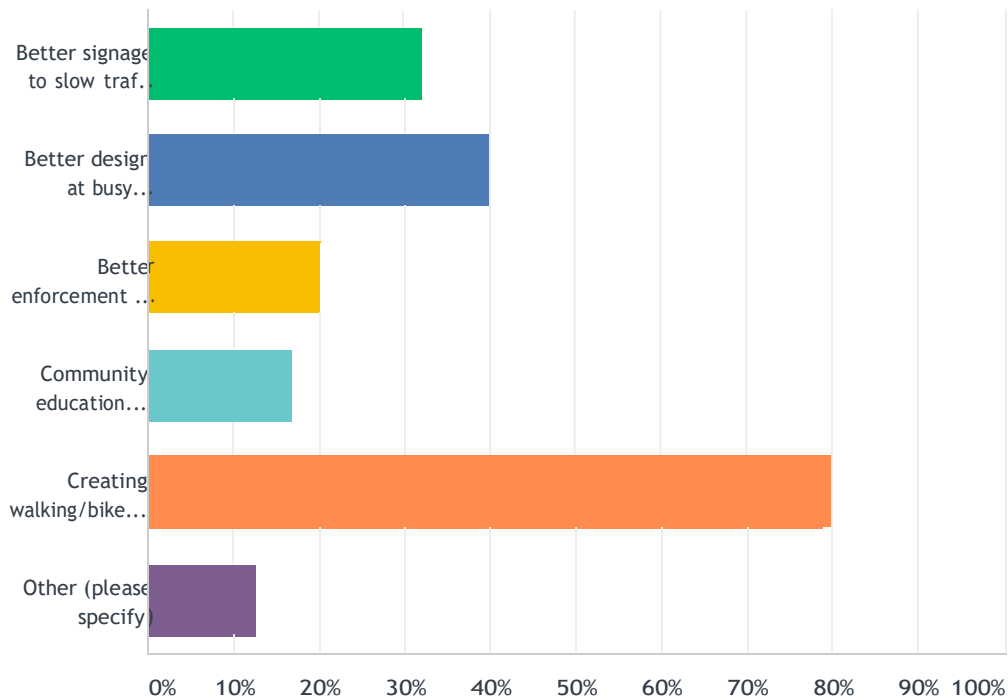

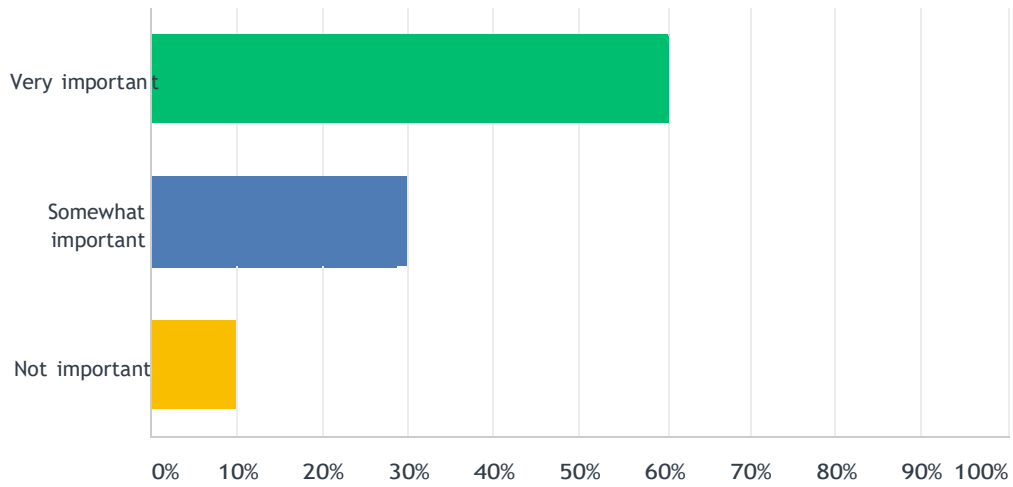

## How important are bicycling safety improvements to your quality of life?

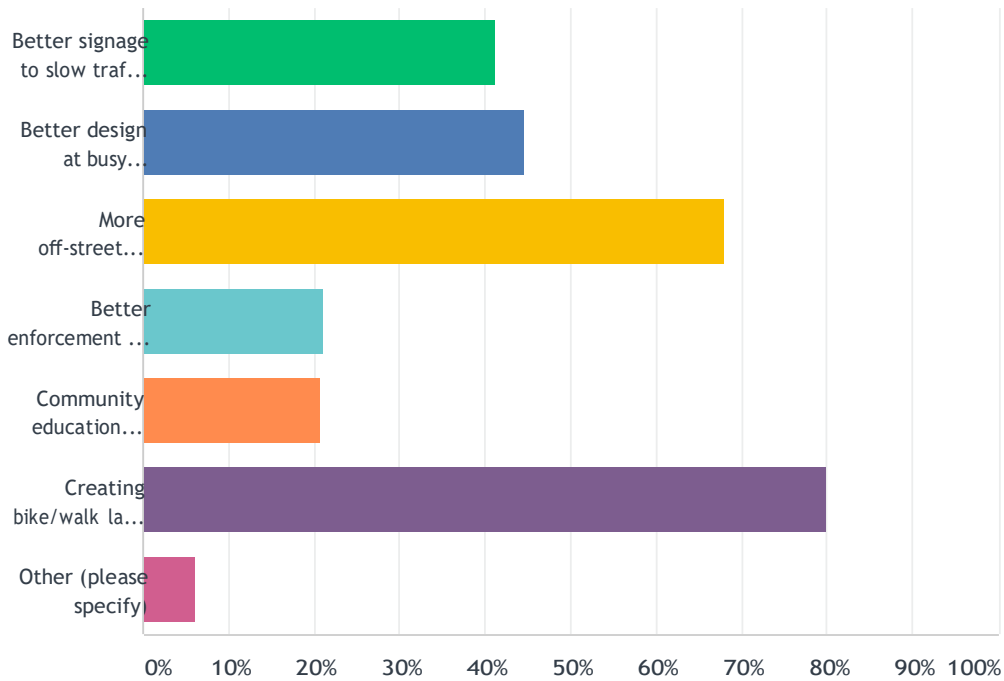

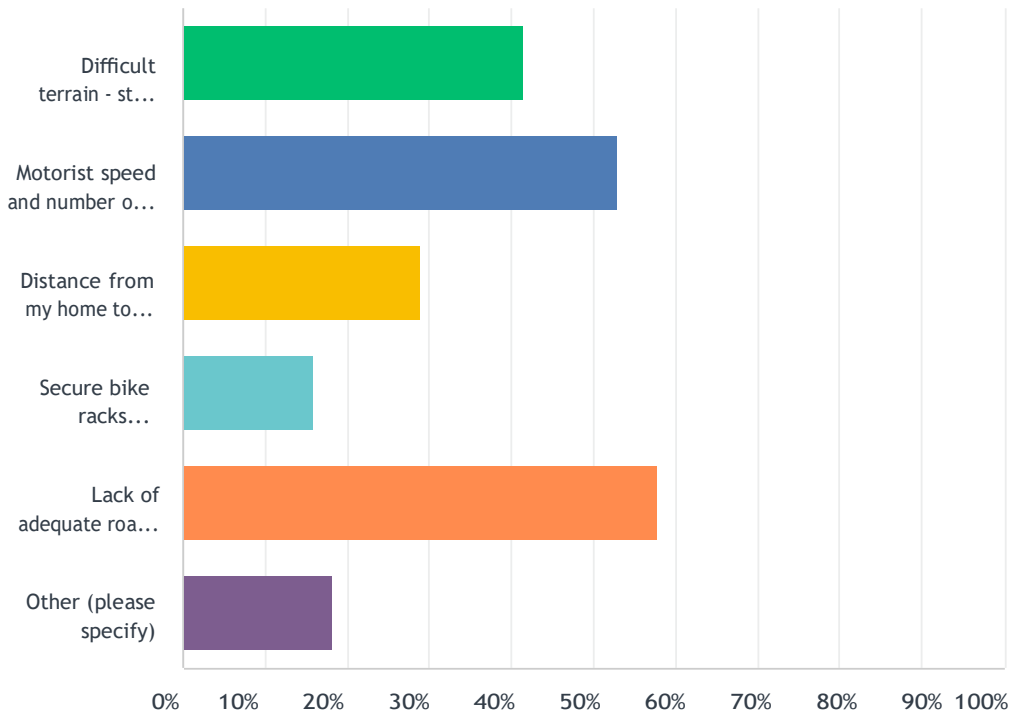
